**Any bird "Deemed to be sick" or infested with parasites, will be removed from the pavilion.**

If sunny the actual auction will take place outdoors in a nearby amphitheatre, bring a hat & sunnies & a comfy chair if you need one. If the weather is rainy, the auction will be in a pavilion, please bring a chair.

# Beginner's Auction Guide



## 1. CHECK WHAT'S IN THE PEN CAREFULLY

**Check the lot number, breed and number of birds,  
and check that they look healthy.**

**THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.**

**YOU ARE BIDDING ON THE BIRDS AS THEY ARE IN THE PEN.**

e.g. If the catalogue says Trio, but there is only a Pair in the pen, you are bidding on a Pair. Please do not complain after the auction that what you have bought isn't what you expected.

**The catalogue is a guide only. If you are not sure, ask a club member for help.**

The D.D.P.P. & C.B.S. Inc accepts no responsibility for incorrect description of any Lot and is conducting the Auction under the Constitution and By-Laws of the D.D.P & P.B.A Inc. and the usual terms & conditions of a Public Auction.

### **CHECKING THE HEALTH OF THE BIRDS**

Look carefully at the birds. Healthy birds have bright clear eyes and look alert. Their combs and the skin around their eyes should be bright red, except for silkies & sebrights which should be maroon-purple. They shouldn't be hunched up and miserable looking. Only birds with crests should be flicking their heads, as they can't see clearly, other birds should not. If you bid on a sick bird and win, YOU NOW OWN that bird.

**If you do notice a sick bird, please bring it to the attention of a club member.**

Our vendors do their best to provide the birds as listed in the catalogue, but the entries are made a few weeks beforehand and sometimes they just aren't able to provide them on the day. Occasionally, they may not notice an ill bird, or have caught their birds in the dark and a sick bird may have been included. Some birds find the auction very stressful and become more susceptible to illness.

## 2. MAKE THE AUCTIONEER'S LIFE EASY

### **LISTEN TO THE AUCTIONEER**

***He will announce any changes to the lots before he offers them for sale.***

All lots are to be offered in numerical order as per the Catalogue. Position yourself where the auctioneer or spotters can see you easily and have your bidder's card ready. If the spotters miss your bid and the lot is sold to someone else, speak up quickly and loudly, and the auctioneer will put the lot up for sale again.

## 3. COLLECTING LOTS

**ALL BIDDERS MUST HAVE THEIR OWN BIDDER'S CARD.**

The account for each bidder's card is to be paid in full, the office **WILL NOT** split up bills.

**BIRDS CAN BE COLLECTED FROM 11 am.**

Club members will release Lots upon presentation of a slip from the Office.

All transactions are to be strictly cash, unless prior arrangements have been made.

Birds that are not sold at auction may be purchased by private treaty, which must be paid for to the D.D.P.P. & C.B.S. Inc. and a receipt obtained prior to release of any birds sold in this manner.

## 4. WHEN YOU GET YOUR BIRDS HOME

Birds' feet and bodies can be sprayed lightly with antiseptic e.g. Dettol, made up as recommended for humans, to kill any germs they may have picked up from the pens. Ideally, you should keep your new birds isolated from the rest of your flock for at least 2 weeks. This will allow any illness the birds may have picked up to become obvious and prevent its spread to the rest of your flock.

Keep chooks & ducks shut in their new home for a week before letting them out. Guinea fowl need to be kept shut in their pen for a month before letting them out. Some feed in the pen and a clipped wing will encourage them to return to the pen to roost. If you let them roost in trees, expect to lose some to foxes in the early morning. During

laying season, try to keep them shut in until lunchtime so they will lay and go clucky in the pen, not in the bush where foxes will take sitting hens.
