If you wish to avail yourself of these penning hours please indicate on entry forms.

This allows the stewards to leave early if all known exhibitors have penned their birds, for dinner starting 6.00 pm.

- No exhibit may be removed before 2.30 pm on show day, but must be removed before 4 pm.
- If picking birds up late prior arrangement must be made prior to event with Show Secretary of the Central Wyandotte Club Mr Ron Marsh.
- Judging to commence at 9.30 am sharp. Birds must be penned by 9.00 am.
- The Mediterranean Poultry Club of Australia Inc. reserves the right to reject any entry without assigning a reason.
- They also reserve the right to add or change Judges listed.
- A JUNIOR shall be aged between 6 and 16 years of age.
A junior may show in both junior and senior classes if he/she so wishes. Junior entry fees only apply to Junior Classes.
