SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. All entries must be made on the forms supplied by the Society.
2. The Society is empowered to exclude any bird which is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease or any other causes the, the entrance fee on which will be forfeited.
3. All birds must be penned between 5.00pm and 7.00pm on Friday or from 7.00am to 8.30am on Saturday or they will be too late for judging. The Society provides coops for all classes of poultry and pigeons and will attend to the exhibits during the Show. All eggs will be destroyed.
4. The Society will be most anxious for care and safety of the poultry and pigeons sent for exhibition or any other property entrusted too them, but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and all other persons that the Society will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any of the poultry, pigeons or other property, whether arising from accident or other causes whatsoever, or from any act or omission of themselves, their agents, officers, servants or other.
5. No person will be admitted to that portion of the building occupied by the judges except committee men, Stewards or Attendants. Any person causing annoyance by making loud comments on the decision of the judge, or other unseemly behaviour, will be expelled from the Show.
6. During the Show the exhibits will be in the custody of the Committee, and may not be touched or handled by the owners or any unauthorised person under any circumstances. In no case will exhibitors be allowed to remove their exhibits before 3.00pm on Saturday unless permission is granted by the Chief Steward and then only under his supervision and all birds must be removed before 5.00pm, on that day, or by arrangement with the section steward.
7. The age of the birds exhibited as young stock under 12 months old to count from 1st June of the year proceeding the Show.
8. The term cock shall mean all male birds over 12 months old, on 1st June preceding the Show. Hen, all female birds over 12 months on 1st June preceding the Show.
9. All protests must be lodged in writing with the CEO not later than 2.30pm, on the judging day and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 which deposit shall, if the protest be deemed frivolous, be forfeited.
10. Wrongly classed birds will not be reclassified on the day.
11. Poultry & Pigeon carry boxes to be removed from pavilion for duration of show.
12. Withdrawal of entries must be advised to the Chief Steward no later than 8.30am on the day of the show.
